## LOOKING TOWARD SUNDAY: A MESSAGE FROM REV. HORTON

If you are like me, you may be overwhelmed with emotions as images and stories continue to emerge from Wednesday's horrific events at the U.S. Capital building: grief, anger, sadness, anxiety, confusion, disbelief...and so many questions. I recorded my sermon on Thursday as I normally do, and to be honest, my mind was reeling and my emotions raw as I made what seemed to be a futile attempt to voice words that might usher in even a shimmer of God's presence. The absence of being together felt even more acute.

With that said, I wonder what might it meant that this occurred on the Day of Epiphany, the day when the Light of the Star led the Magi to the Christ child? To me, this timing is not merely coincidence, for on January 6, we did see the Light shine on our country... the ugliness of White Supremacy was uncovered, the dangers of extremism and Christian Nationalism were revealed, and the deep sins of neglecting to love our neighbor were made manifest on this day.

On Sunday, the Light will lead us to Remember our Baptism. As we hear the Gospel passage, <u>Mark 1: 4-11</u>, we see Jesus enter the muddy waters of the Jordan, rising with the blessing of the Holy Spirit to bring in God's kingdom on Earth. This begins our series, **Follow Me**, where we see that even though the Star was

easy for the Magi to follow, the path never seems to remain that Bright. You and I are called to follow the Light even when it flickers dimly. God leads us into the places where love, justice, and peace of God is absent; the places we'd rather not go.


Please join me Sunday. We need reminders of our baptism. We need to remember that we are claimed by God for God's purposes in this world.. even when the Light seems to waver.
