Deuteronomy 26: 1-11 (Common English Bible)

The priest will then take the basket from you and place it before the LORD your God's altar. Then you should solemnly state before the LORD your God, "My father was a starving Aramean. He went down to Egypt, living as an immigrant there with few family members, but that is where he became a great nation, mighty and numerous. The Egyptians treated us terribly, oppressing us and forcing hard labor on us. So, we cried out for help to the LORD, our ancestors' God. The LORD heard our call. 


